**Once Upon A Time**

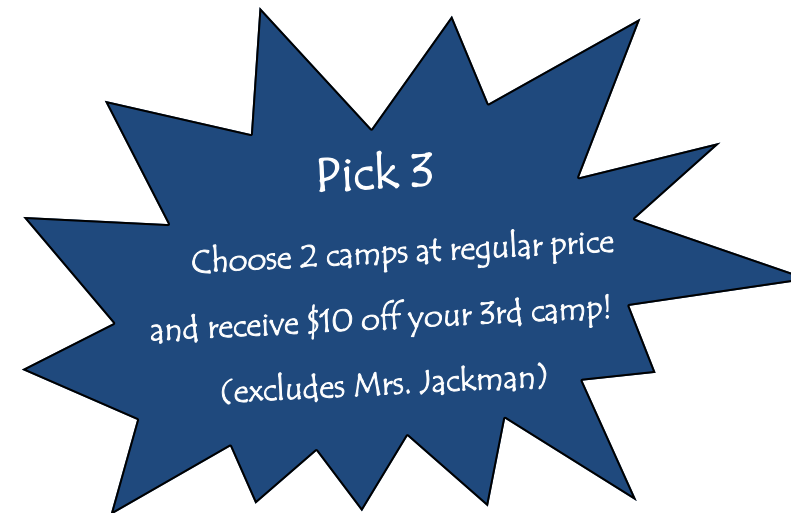
